CLASSIC



CLEAR WINNER

This surround achieves a virtually invisible enclosure, which helps the sense of space in this narrow bathroom. The shower is from Swadling Brassware, the basin is Duravit. **Similar bathroom**, £25,000, Rabih Hage.



SOFT FOCUS

Delicate mosaic-style tiles soften the look of the contemporary shower in this generous walk-in wet room. **Lake House range mosaic tiles**, £1,100/sq m, Mesguich Mosaik. **Spey double-ended free-standing bath**, £3,450, Drummonds.

IN A NICHE

A tiled shower area, with mosaic wall tiles and Sirrah floor tiles from Capitol Ceramics, conceals the plumbing and accommodates a cut-away recess for soaps and shampoo. **Similar bathroom**, from £15,000, Flow London.



ROOM FOR TWO

Save time with a luxurious double shower. **SLX controls** with deluge showerheads cost £660 each, and are enclosed in the **Ultrabond dual access wet room panel**, from £2,151, with a discreet **Designa shower tray**, £502; all Showerlux.

DRAMATIC



SUBTLE TEXTURE

A dramatic backdrop of chiselled, layered limestone adds interest to this spacious wet room, which features a rain shower and custom-made back-lit vanity unit in teak and limestone. **Similar bathroom**, from £18,000, Lawson Robb.



COLOUR SPLASH

Add a sense of drama to a large walk-in wet room with the smart **Rei shower column** in vibrant orange. It features a fixed raindrop showerhead, plus a handheld shower on a flexible hose and four body jets, around £1,450, Jacuzzi. ■
